What a joy it is to share this Annual Report as it gives us the opportunity to inform you of the accomplishments we were able to do in the fiscal year. Here are some highlights:

- Love walks in Portland, Grand Avenue apartments, Chickasaw and California where we prayed with 188 people.
- Bike giveaways – two events; 215 bikes given away thanks to the Marine Corp “Toys for Tots” program.
- Breaking the cycle events (2) which featured inspirational speakers and giveaways of clothing and back to school supplies for 47 people.
- Educational trip to the Ark Encounter – 17 youth.
- Camp Change – 31 youth total for the two events.
- Drive and Drop delivery of food, cleaning supplies and toiletries during COVID-19 for 874 homes.
