What a joy it is to share this Annual Report as it gives us the opportunity to inform you of the accomplishments we were able to do in 2022. Here are some highlights:

- January 3, 2022 **Dream Center Academy Christian School** (DCACS) opened its doors to 11 Star Scholars. DCACS is a private Christian School. Website: www.dcachristianschool.org
- Bike giveaways – two events; 215 bikes given away thanks to the Marine Corp “Toys for Tots” program.
- **L.O.V.E. WALKS:** May 8th and October 14 of 2022 in the Shawnee Community. There were 100 volunteers who blessed 100 residents with practical needs, gift cards (Visa, Kroger) food, home repair and most of all **CHRISTIAN LOVE!**
- **CAMPCHANGE** – June 25th, 22 youth enjoyed canoeing, archery, fishing, team building, swimming at Cedar Ridge Park. There were 21 volunteers on hand to **LAVISH CHRISTIAN LOVE** on the youth.
- **L.I.F.E. (Love Inspiring Future Excellence™)** Summer Enrichment Program began June 27th. The program went for 6 weeks Monday thru Friday. During the 6 weeks program our youth were enriched with reading, math, drama, spoken word, technology, art, field trips, and more.
- **L.I.F.E. (Love Inspiring Future Excellence™)** After School Program began August 20th for 25 enrolled students. The program last 39 weeks and works to enrich learning capabilities for our youth through structured engagement while also providing a safe and encouraging environment along with Hot Meals and **Great Christian LOVE!** Services offered: tutoring, S.T.E.M. Projects, theater Arts, Dance and more
- **Christmas Gift Extravaganza** – we blessed 200 to 250 families and their children at Christmas time with clothing, Kroger’s and Visa gift cards, pay \$100 towards their bill of choice, and a new bike and toys. This event is in partnership with Marines Toys For Tots, Southeast Christian Prospect, The Duthie Foundation, and other philanthropist, and supporters.
